In accordance with your instructions I have investigated and taken control of the property of the above man as recorded on his registration form as follows:

Real Property:

"Alberni Assessment district. Lots Four (4) and Five (5), of Section Twenty-one (21) Clayoquot District. Plan 1116."

Buildings:

"None on the above property. The declarant owns a house at P.O. Box 10, Ucluelet, B.C., which is erected on Mr. Littleton's property, 5 room bungalow, wooden frame house."

Personal Property:

"1 Stove, 1 Cross-cut Saw, Kitchen Utensils, and Fishing equipment, stored at P.O. Box 10, Ucluelet, B.C."

In connection therewith I have to report as follows:

Location:

Ucluelet is a village on Barclay Sound on the West Coast of Vancouver Island, B.C., about sixty miles west of Port Alberni, B.C. There is a Japanese settlement at Fraser's Bay adjacent to the village.

The settlement consists of nine houses built on the foreshore or on land close to the high water mark. The location commands an excellent view of Uclulet Harbour. The approach to the settlement is by a rough trail from the village, water or along the foreshore.

A Rough plan of the subdivision and index of property owners is attached.

Real Property:

The property described at Lots 4 and 5, Alberni District, are situated at Fraser's Bay, Ucluelet, B.C. There are no buildings thereon. The legal description if correctly given.

According to the Provincial Collector's office, Alberni, B.C., the assessed owners are Tomizo Yamanaka and Senichi Ikari. The lots are assessed for \$100.00 each. Taxes for 1942 were \$3.00 and have been paid.

A Certificate of Encumbrance is on file showing that Tomizo Yamanaka and Senichi Ikari are joint tenants.

When I made my inspection of properties at Fraser's Bay I observed that some lumber was piled on one of the lots. I am making enquiries regarding this. The lots are fairly level and are next to well-built houses, and above the high water level.

In connection with the other property, namely, a five-roomed bungalow on Mr. Littleton's property, this building is erected on land leased from the Lyche Estate. I understand from Mr. Littleton-- the agent for the Japanese-- that since the departure of the Japanese he has rented the house to a Mr. Hammingston and is collecting the rent. I have not been able to ascertain from Mr. Littleton or his solicitor just what the situation is in respect to the buildings on this land.

Personal Property:

In the house at Lyche's Bay was an old stove worth about \$4.00, two small kitchen tables worth about \$1.00, and a wooden bedstead of little value. No trace was found of the fishing equipment.

Insurance:

None is carried.

Liabilities:

None are recorded.

Recommendations:

I recommend:

- (1) That in respect to the vacant lots, no action need be taken in respect thereto at present.
- (2) That in respect to the house at Lyche's Bay, Mr. Littleton be asked to state definitely what the situation is. I understand that Mr. Littleton made some arrangements with the Japanese that if certain houses were rented he would retain half the rent to apply on the lease and remit the other half to the Japanese owner.

I further recommend that Mr. Littleton be instructed to remit the rents (if any) to the Custodian's office.
