GENERAL SUMMARY

File 798

Re: Fern MACHIDA #10796

July 3, 1946.

On March 24, 1942, this man signed a declaration to the Custodian. He was evacuated on March 26, 1942.

In his declaration to the Custodian he reported, as follows:

"2 nets, 1 gasoline tank, boat tools, value \$290.00 left with Mill Bay Cannery, Nass River, B. C. Also fishing boat, value \$1,400.00 bought from Mill Bay Cannery, but only partly paid for; \$600.00 paid already, \$800.00 still owing, boat in custody of Sunnyside Cannery, Skeena River, B. C. (B.C.Packers)."

In regard to the property declared, records in our possession show that the vessel "My Hope", Prince Rupert Lic.No. 983, was released from custody to the licensed owners, British Columbia Packers Ltd. in March, 1942. On September 8, 1944, British Columbia Packers Ltd. informed us that the vessel was valued at \$1,000.00; that MACHIDA owed the company \$801.75, and that the sum of \$198.25 was paid direct to him by the company on March 30, 1942, in full for his equity. Some of the items declared appear to be part of the boat equipment and in all probability were included in the settlement. No inquiry has been received from MACHIDA in regard to his nets, and as settlement was made direct between cannery and Japanese in practically all cases where nets of any value were left at canneries, we have assumed that the 2 nets declared were handled in this manner.

The only liability revealed by this file is that dealt with in the previous paragraph.
