MEMORANDUM TO: MAJOR A. HOLISTER

FROM: MR. K. W. WRIGHT

RE: JAPAN & CANADA TRUST SAVINGS COMPANY

With reference to our memo to you of March 18th last, we beg to advise you that we have received the following replies from the Internees mentioned therein.

File No. 124 - P/W A-353, MEGI, Kenjiro: "In or about 1919 I withdrew most of my account balance from the Japan and Canada Trust Savings Coy., Vancouver, B. C. and left about one dollar or so in my account.

I opened the account while I was in Vancouver, B. C. and I presume I mentioned my address as 433 Alexander Street, Vancouver, B. C. I never touched the account since, and have no pass book, and do not know its account number".

File No. 202 - P/W A-184, IZUMOTO, Isaburo: "I had an account with the Japan and Canada Trust Savings, Company of Vancouver, B. C. under the name of I Izumoto, however I withdrew most of the credit, and left a small sum with them, I believe.

My address at the time was 400 Block Powell Street, Vancouver, B. C. I have no pass book with me and do not know its account number".

File No. 252 - P/W A-207, HANAHASHI, Toshiro: "I have no deposit with the Japan and Canada Trust Savings, Coy., mentioned in this letter".

File No. 273 - P/W A-40, KANAKI, Sengiro: "I had an account with the Japan and Canada Trust Savings Co., of Vancouver, B. C. in or about 1923-26 and I withdrew all of my credit".

File No. 1000 - P/W A-313, SUKIMOTO, Seiji: "I have no deposit with the Japan and Canada Trust Savings Co., Vancouver, B. C."

Evacuee File 15174/08485, Sanjiro KAWASAKI and  
Internee File 798, P.W.A. 60, Reg. 00462 Sanjiro  
KAWASAKI

I am sending you herewith the two files above mentioned,  
same name, different registration numbers. If you will peruse the  
internee file you will see that this office mentions War Savings  
Certificates and an account in the Japan and Canada Trust Savings  
Company in both of which the Internee has denied any interest. In  
our letter to the Camp Commandant dated 15th December, 1942 I see the  
address Slocan City is mentioned and the card in the Evacuee file  
15174 is marked with the rubber stamp "Slocan." I think, therefore,  
that the War Savings Certificates, and perhaps also the account in the  
Japan and Canada, might belong to this Evacuee. Would you mind having  
the Administrator in your Department make some effort to clear this up.

\* Name in Depositors' List given as Shozo KAWASAKI.  
No such name in our records. May have returned to Japan.

Further, on May 27th, 1943 we received from the Receiver  
General \$25.08 refund of 1942 National Defence tax in the name of  
Sanjiro KAWASAKI. The filing room supplied us with the information  
"file number 4360, registration 00462" and the account was opened in  
the Evacuee Section on Mr. Alexander's instructions.

Evacuee file 4360 has been transferred to Internee file 798  
but no instructions were issued to us at any time to transfer the  
account.

It is not at all clear to me that this balance of \$25.08  
belongs to KAWASAKI, Int. 798 as there appears to be no evidence in  
this office to suggest that it might not be equally possible for it  
to belong to Evacuee file 15174.




