PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

File No. 802

March 8, 1946.

Re: MIYAHARA, Choru #08750

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 19, 1942. He left the protected area on March 21, 1942. It is not shown by the file when this man was moved to Vancouver from Stillwater.

He declared the following tools left in the bush at the camp where he had been engaged in cutting shingle bolts: 1 falling saw, 7 wedges, 1 peevie, 1 pick, 2 axe-handles, 3 saw-handles, 1 crowbar, and 2 filing files. This equipment was not inventoried by this office, because of the inaccessibility of the place where it had been left.

He declared blankets and sheets in transit per C.P.R. These we can safely assume were delivered to him.

He declared Dominion of Canada Bond valued at \$50.00 in his possession. This did not come under the control of this office.

In letter of October 23, 1945, MIYAHARA stated that in addition to the tools, he had 60 cords of shingle bolts, priced at \$2.40, left behind in the bush. This matter may be cleared up when the affairs of M. Ebisuzaki Co. are liquidated. xx

The file reveals no other property.

This summary is certified to be in accordance with information on file.

MEMORANDUM

To: Stillwater Files

From: Mr. Green

There is very little that can be done in the way of protection of Japanese property at Stillwater.

Mr. Logan visited this place in June 1942 and reports on 4/76 as follows:

"The two camps, Teira and Suzuki, are reached from Stillwater as follows:

4 Miles by car
9 Miles by boat
3/4 Mile on foot
4 1/2 Miles by boat
4 Miles on foot

TOTAL: 22 1/4 Miles

"No one can get in without Mr. McHair knowing, as his craft must be used to cross the Lakes.

"Mr. Logan checked all the equipment to be found in the two camp bunk houses and list are given herewith. It was quite impossible to decide which tools belonged to which man. Additionally, there are also some tools left in the bush which can only be located by the Japanese themselves.

"In short, such equipment as has been left behind, is perfectly safe as it could not be removed without Mr. McHair knowing about it. However, for the most part, it cannot be identified and we shall therefore have to advise the Japanese concerned that we can only assume that the tools they have declared to the Custodian are actually there. It would cost more than the value of these tools to take them away."

Unfortunately, it appears that this report is a little optimistic as thefts of the McHair Company's equipment

has since taken place. There is nothing, however, that can be economically done as appears from Mr. Pat McNeil's letter of July 21st on file 2876 written in answer to a request of Mrs. Hideo Hiyamoto for shipment of some of her effects. This is quoted below for the benefit of other Stillwater files.

"I cannot ship you any of the enclosed articles as they are away back in the woods. And as the camp is shut down there is no way to take this stuff out only by packing it on your back. And it is impossible to get anybody to do that, especially these times."

I am in receipt of yours of the fifteenth inst. and am here to inform you that I have not recovered my axes cut saws nor logging tool. Since the ~~entire~~ Japanese personnel in that camp was compelled to evacuate at that time, I was forced to leave the tools there, under nobody's protection, for none remained to look after our interests. Along with my tools, I also left empty carts of shingles priced at two dollars and forty cents, at that time.

At the time of the repatriation of certain Japanese, who volunteered for this purpose, all funds and assets were declared. In this instance, Mr. Miyahara turned in \$360.00 and indicated that he had something to come from the Income Tax Department in connection with his 1943 Savings Portion. We issued him GT-JAP-1 Form No. 1313 for \$360.00, which was handed to him, and he took it with him. Notification of this transaction went through Washington. Subsequently we have sent him the following remittances: GT-J-1 No. 3012 for \$10.84, GT-J-1 No. 3067 for \$96.00, and GT-J-1 No. 3121 for \$11.99.
