On September 25th, the Inverness Cannery wrote to the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee and we were referred the letter to us, that the Inverness Cannery had the under-mentioned nets for which the following offers had been offered but rejected by the Japanese.

1. Inverness - 1 Used Coho Net	\$40.00	
1- " Spring Net	20.00	\$60.00
2. Inverness - 1 Used Coho Net		\$30.00

The Inverness Cannery asked if we would give these nets as they wanted to get rid of them.

There is no point in spending money doing this especially as the nets may not be saleable elsewhere and we would like, therefore, to suggest that you do what the writer is doing to similar nets belonging to evacuated Japanese, namely, write and tell them that they had better take these offers before the nets further deteriorate. There is no likelihood of other offers being received.



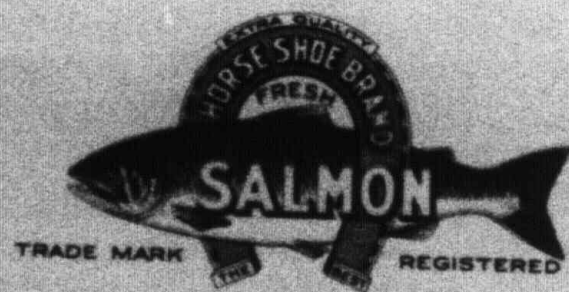
