This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 30, 1942. He was evacuated on May 1, 1942.

In his declaration he reported a fishing boat in custody. The records of the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee show that this boat was sold and the net proceeds in the amount of \$452.90 were paid to KONDO on August 31, 1942.

He reported a \$50.00 Victory Bond and a \$1,000.00 policy with the Yorkshire Savings & Loan Assn. in his own possession. These items did not come under the control of this office.

The account of this man was credited with the sum of \$21.75 as refund of expenses incurred at the time of the impounding of his boat. This amount is being remitted to KONDO today.

The account of this man was credited with the sum of \$19.64 as proportionate share of the assets of the Tofino Japanese Association. This amount was remitted to him on August 3, 1945.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.

The above properties at present under the care of C. W. Sharp. Very little property left; either sold or shipped to Vancouver for storage. No inventories taken of property left behind due to hasty evacuation.

One school house, to the value of \$1000. owned jointly by the Clayoquot Tofino Trollers Association (Japanese) and in the name of Mitsuzo Nakagawa, legal description unknown by undersigned.

One house purchased by Haru Kimoto, with lot to the value of \$1200. but as payments on the property to former owner have not been completed, the Title Deed is not in Kimoto's name.

The other Japanese residents rented houses from John Eik, Tofino. A certain amount of furnishings, fishing gear left in these houses being cared for in the meanwhile by Mr. Eik. No inventories taken.

The balance of Japanese property at Tofino was shipped to Vancouver when evacuated and the small amount that has been left behind is well packed and stored in their homes; all windows being boarded. I understand that the Japanese Custodian of properties has been in touch with Mr. C. W. Sharp and has received a more detailed description than above.

All Clayoquot Japanese residences, which have been rented from P. Malon, Owner of the island under the care of William White, Special Police Reserve in Tofino making routine patrols of all above mentioned houses.
