PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

August 26, 1946.

Re: Eisaku MIURA, Reg. No. 09100

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 26, 1942, the same day on which he was evacuated.

In his declaration he reported a list of chattels left in the possession of his wife to be stored at Woodfibre, including 6 boxes, 2 beds, a sofa and a stove. 3 of the boxes were shipped to MIURA in February, 1943; one of the boxes containing a sewing machine was not declared by his wife and we assume she either took it with her on her evacuation or disposed of it prior to her evacuation, no disposition is shown of an electric motor declared by both this man and his wife, and the remainder of the chattels declared were sold at auction. We also received in Vancouver a number of articles from Woodfibre identified as the property of this man. These were sold at auction and the net proceeds credited to the account of this man, a total credit of \$22.45. We are today remitting this amount to him.

He reported a bank account with a balance of \$424.42 in the Royal Bank of Canada, Vancouver, and a \$1,000.00 policy with the Manufacturer's Life Insurance Co. Neither of these items came under the control of this office.

The account of this man was credited with the sum of \$6.40 received as refund of 15% wage deduction for 1941. This was remitted to him on May 25, 1943.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.
