We have just received a communication from the Evacuation Section as follows: -

"In a letter to us dated September 10th the Office of the Registrar, War Savings Certificates, 350 King Edward Avenue, Ottawa, asks whether or not Mr. Kitaro KONDO, c/o Mrs. M. Lynde, 1366 Seymour Street, Vancouver, is eligible to receive proceeds of War Savings Certificates having a face value of \$25.00, the Certificates having been forwarded to the Office of the Registrar for redemption.

Our files indicate that this individual is an internee and you may wish, therefore, to communicate immediately with the Office of the Registrar."

This is to advise that notice of internment was received by us on the 29th of June, 1942. According to the statement of assets and liabilities which we have on file signed by the Internee, he does not own any securities and we would be obliged if you would hold up the transfer and let us have information as to how these certificates reached you and instructions as to resittance. These certificates should have been transferred to this office in accord with the Consolidated Regulations Respecting Trading with the Enemy (1939). Arrangements have been made with the Internment Branch not to forward funds without the approval of the Camp Commandant and it is therefore our duty to stop all shortcuts that may be attempted by Internees. Your early reply would be appreciated.



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
Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:
