

This small credit was remitted to the Treasury Department early in 1947, as per letter of March 5, 1947 on file, after repatriation of Mr. Risaburo KONDO to Japan on August 2, 1946.

No assets were declared to the Custodian by Mr. Kondo.

CLAIMS:

A claim for \$125.80 was filed by Vancouver General Hospital on April 21st, 1942. As this man had no account with the office, other than the above \$1.30, this claim remains unpaid.


