CHATELS:

The above, who made his declaration to the Custodian on April 1/42 and was evacuated on May 17/42, declared a box of carpenter's tools, left in the care of his father at 203 Powell St. This address has been visited by the writer on a dozen different occasions but no trace of carpenter's tools has been found. The quarters at the rear of this building where the IKEDA family lived is now in possession of many Chinese, with doors open to everyone. Under such circumstances the task of claiming chattels and offering protection to same is fraught with the utmost difficulty. As Mitsuo IKEDA has not addressed us on the subject of his tools it is quite likely that he took them with him at the time he went to Selsque, B.C.

SPECIFIED  
ARTICLES:

A Victory Consol combination radio was surrendered by the above to the A.C.M.P. and handed by them to the Custodian on Jan. 27/44. It was sold at auction for the net sum of \$41.57 and this amount credited to his account.

His folding camera was mailed to him on Dec. 13/45. Shipping expenses in the sum of \$ .31 were deducted from his credit balance with this office.

His remaining balance of \$41.26 was remitted to him on January 2/46.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

GENERAL SUMMARY

This man, who was evacuated on May 17, 1942, signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 1, 1942. In his declaration he reported ownership of the following:

Chattels: One box of carpenter's tools, value \$100.00, left in care of Father, Chubei IKEDA (File 6686). A memorandum on this file, under date of January 22, 1943, states that these tools were moved to 992 Powell Street under the father's name. File 6686 reveals nothing in regard to these tools. It is possible that these are still at 992 Powell Street. Mr. Spain has been asked for further information in regard to these.

Radio: The radio described in Specified Articles Memorandum, was reported to this office by the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, to whom it had been surrendered, as shown by the receipt filed under date of December 12, 1945. This radio was sold by the Custodian for the net sum of \$41.57, which was credited to the account of Mitsuo IKEDA.

Camera: The camera, described in Specified Articles Memorandum, was surrendered to the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, as shown by the receipt filed under date of December 12, 1945. It was reported to this office by the police and was handed to the Custodian on January 27, 1944. On December 13, 1945, at IKEDA's request this camera was mailed to him at Greenwood, B. C.

This file reveals no other property of any kind. No liabilities revealed in this file.
