



2. The Internee replies as follows, quote,
" I made an application for the refund of my transportation fare from Ocean Falls, B.C. to Vancouver, B. C., in 1943 according to a notice of the B.C. Security Commission to that effect. I was later advised that about thirty-nine dollars(\$39.00) had been refunded and credited to my account with the Custodian. And later I was notified by my wife that she had received about nineteen(\$19.00) from the B.C. Security Commission as her share of the refund, while she was in Tashme, B.C.

Therefore, I understand that still there is about nineteen dollars(\$19.00) of refund in my account with the Custodian.

My Registration number is 11492, and the correct way to spell my name is Yeiji KOZONO, however, I am also known as Eiji KOZONO. Therefore, I wish that the Custodian will make a further check up about my share of refund of fare into my above mentioned two names." signed Y.Kozono." end of quote.
