DOGFISH GEAR LEFT AT THE BEAVER CANNERY,
RIVERS INLET

Reference to file A/52 will show that this dogfish gear was valued in the summer of 1942 at \$65.00. In late August the writer turned down an offer of \$50.00 as it was not up to the valuation set by Mr. Leckie.

In October, however, Mr. Johnston arrived in Vancouver from Rivers Inlet and advised the writer that the dogfish gear should be sold for anything it would fetch as it would be worthless in the spring of 1943.

The best offer that could be obtained was for \$25.00 which has been accepted and credited equally to the five Japanese whose names were attached to this gear.




