Re: Zenichi KITAMURA, #03965

The Nash Motor-car, declared on JP, was dealt with under No. 101 - Vancouver Car.

This vehicle was described as,

1925 Nash Fordor Coupe, Serial No. 291434, Engine No. 175299.

When delivered to the RCMP the car carried no licence plate, and the dash slip in the car envelope is for the year 1938.

The RCMP report states that the condition "appears very poor."

The car was surrendered by Zenichi KITAMURA, but was registered in name of Zenkuro KITAMURA (Zenkuro KITAMURA's signature indicates the reason for the mis-spelling of the given name).

In June or July, 1942, the car was examined by Mr. Grone, of McDermott Motors, and was found to be of not sufficient value to warrant the expense of removing the car from Hastings Park. It was, therefore, given to the Red Cross Salvage. Confirmation of this, by Messrs. Grone, E. T. Reid and T. Ellis, is on File 7011, the file of Zenkuro KITAMURA.
