A quantity of household effects and a trunk of clothing, left at his residence, 568 Powell Street, Vancouver, in his mother's care. On October 14, 1942, his mother, Teo NOZUYE, File 9466, signed a statement that all chattels declared by her son had been disposed of prior to evacuation.



Dear Sir:

Your file has just been reviewed and it is noted that when you signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 1, 1942, you stated that you were the owner of a quantity of household effects and clothing left in the care of your mother at 568 Powell Street, Vancouver. On October 14, 1942, your mother notified this office that all chattels declared by you had been disposed of prior to your evacuation.

In your declaration you also reported six War Savings Certificates, in your own possession. These did not come under the control of the Custodian.

You declared a Sun Life Assurance Company life insurance policy in your own possession. The Monarch Life Insurance Company reported a policy in your name. Neither of these policies came under the control of the Custodian.

Dr. Matasaburo UCHIDA registered a claim for the sum of \$20.00 against you, as you were advised on July 16, 1943. You have not given us any information in regard to this claim. We have notified Dr. UCHIDA of this and have given him your present address so that he may write to you direct.

It would appear that we have accounted for all property of every kind left by you in the protected area which vested in the Custodian, and in order that you may confirm this, we enclose a stamped, addressed envelope for your convenience in replying.
