CHATELS: No personal chattels were declared by the above Japanese person on his Statement of Assets and Liabilities, but in a letter (undated) received by the Custodian on April 29, 1946, Kasuo MURATA stated he left a Duffle Bag containing personal effects at 325 W. 4th Avenue, Vancouver, but had not reported it to the Custodian. The Custodian advised him on May 9, 1946, the investigation by the Chattels Department disclosed that no duffle bag tagged with his name was found at the above address when Japanese chattels were removed to Custodian storage. At Mr. Murata's request the former Japanese owner of 325 W. 4th Avenue was forwarded to him by the Custodian on May 22nd, 1946.

No other assets of any kind whatsoever belonging to the above Japanese person are revealed on this file.
