Further to our letter of March 10th and reply from the above named contained in your communication of March 16th, we forwarded the Application for Cash Surrender to Mrs. Tsunekichi NAKATSU for her signature and also asked for the policy, so that it may be sent to the Sun Life in order to obtain the Cash Surrender Value as requested.

We have received a letter from Mrs. NAKATSU dated April 18th in which she questions the advisability of this move and asks whether the request to cash this policy in came directly from the son. Her letter reads as follows:
