On July 27, 1943, there was shipped from Victoria to  
Kunizo Uyede, File 483, father of Mamoru, one crated  
bicycle. Since the bicycle remaining at Willows in  
the name of the Uyede family was the bicycle of Mamoru,  
as shown by Memo of December 1, 1942, it would seem  
that his bicycle was the one shipped to his father.
