


Re: Masato MATSUMURA - Reg. No. 00368

The above Japanese registered with this office on the 21st March, 1942, and declared some personal effects left at the G.P.R. Depot, but these apparently were taken with him. He also declared a Manufacturers Life Insurance policy. On the 4th May, 1943, the Insurance Company notified us that Masato MATSUMURA had applied for the cash surrender value of this policy, and as he had no liabilities, the Custodian advised the Company that we had no objection to their sending it to MATSUMURA direct.

MATSUMURA returned to Japan on the General Meigs on the 17th June, 1946, and owes the Treasury Department the sum of \$200.00.

No further administration is necessary on this file and it may now be closed.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.

We have a policy on the above-mentioned life for \$2,000.00, issued on the Twenty Payment Life Plan in 1936. The insured was born in Port Hammond, B. C. on the 28th of July, 1918. When he applied for the policy he was working in a Pulp Mill at Woodfibre, B. C.. In his application he named his father, Shigematsu Matsumura, of Vancouver, B. C., as beneficiary.

He now wishes to surrender this policy for cash, and the value, after deducting certain premium indebtedness, amounts to \$114.09.

His present address is c/o Merritt Bros., Grimsby, Ontario and he states that his father's present address is Lemon Creek, Slocan, B. C., to which place he has been evacuated. The father was born in Japan, but came to Canada on the 15th of April, 1893. His occupation was Cannery Watchman.
