

This file reveals that NISHI owned no real property in any protected area of B.C. and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATELS: NISHI registered with the Custodian on May 22/42 and was interned on May 29/42. He signed a "No property" card stating he owned no property of any kind whatsoever in any protected area of B.C.

MONEYS RECEIVABLE: We received the sum of \$11.76 from the Department of Mines and Resources to be credited to the account of NISHI. This represented wages he had earned while working for that Department in May, 1942.

BANK ACCOUNT: The balance of his Bank account with the Bank of Montreal in the sum of \$1.00 was remitted to this office and credited to his account.

A cheque for \$12.76 was remitted to the Camp Commandant on Jan. 15/44 to be credited to the Canteen Fund of NISHI.

On July 9/46 we received from the Camp Commandant at Angler the sum of \$6.42, being the balance in the account of NISHI. This is his only credit with the Custodian.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.
