PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY August 26, 1946. File No. 862 Res Satero MATSURERA, Reg. No. 02294 (Deceased) On March 21, 1942, this man signed a declaration to the Custodian. He was evacuated on May 11, 1942. He died at Brelowne, B. C. on October 10, 1945. His wife died at Minto, B. C. on May 25, 1946. In his declaration to the Oustodian he reported a list of goods, left in the custody of Mr. Cook, watchman at North Galiano, Cowichan Saltery Co. camp, who was occupying the house formerly occupied by Mr. MATSUMURA. Of the goods declared by MATSUMURA, some were shipped to him, some were sold and some are not accounted for. For details see the Chattel Summary and Schedule. This wan declared no property other than his chattels and none is revealed by his file. His credit balance at this time if \$26.34. It is possible that some of the funds transferred from the account of Shigemateu MATSUMURA to Chattel Sumpense may have been derived from the sale of chattels of Sataro MATSUMURA, but in view of the death of both MATSUMURA and his wife, who as far as we know leave no heirs, nothing further is being done about this at the present time. The sum of \$26.34 has been credited to the account of this man from eals of shattels. Some goods, not declared, were shipped to Sataro MATSHARM from Borth Galdano prior to his execution. 

However, as Sataro Matsumura died on October 10, 1945, leaving no known heirs and no other known claims, we are transferring the balance of \$26.34 from this account to the account of the Coulchen Saltery limited in this office.
