Dear Sir:

During September of this year, Mr. Richard Seymour of Sooke, B.C. produced at this office a letter from your Department dated September 1st, your file #343, relating to a Ford Truck owned by Isaso Ono, which under Order-in-Council PC 1665 had been sold to Mr. Seymour. It bore no licence of any kind and a check of the engine number resulted in the number CAA104065 being shown. We made a thorough search of our files, and can find no Ford Truck bearing this engine number.

The nearest we can come to the above engine number CAA104065, is CA104065. As you will see these two numbers are very similar with the exception of one serial letter, and while this is a small matter, it is of great importance in the maintenance of our records, as it may be an entirely different car.

The Ford Truck bearing Engine #CA104065 is a 1929 model, last owned by a Chinaman by the name of Chong (no other name given), of 1726 Government St., Victoria, whose last licence was CA-657, taken out in 1940. We have gone to considerable trouble in an effort to locate this Chinaman, and ascertain if the motor vehicle was ever transferred to Isaso Ono, but as far as we can find, the Chinaman has gone to China, and it is now necessary for us to establish whether the motor vehicle was ever transferred to the Japanese. In the meantime, Mr. Seymour has paid a registration fee of \$10.00 in order to obtain a current motor vehicle licence, but if we can establish that the truck owned by Chong is the same truck that was sold by you to Mr. Seymour on behalf of Isaso Ono, Mr. Seymour is entitled to a refund of the \$10.00 registration fee, and I would

appreciate your help in ascertaining from Isaso Ono if the truck in question was ever owned by the Chinaman, Chong.

Dear Sir:

We have received a number of inquiries requesting further particulars in connection with recent statements covering disposition made of motor vehicles and we are, therefore, sending you this general letter of explanation.

The Custodian decided it would be in the best interests of the owners to sell Japanese motor vehicles due, not only to the rapid deterioration of paint, batteries and tires, but also because of storage and other charges which were accumulating.

Appraisals of all cars were obtained by the Custodian through competent and unbiased experts.

Deductions made for liens on said cars are self-explanatory.

The administration expenses deducted covered only insurance and storage charges incurred in each case for each car between the time said vehicle was impounded until date of sale of said vehicle.

The proceeds remaining thereafter were transferred by the Custodian to the credit of your account in this office.
