

Life Insurance: On March 30, 1942, Kazuo Nishimura declared to the Custodian that he held a \$1,000.00 Life Insurance Policy with Monarch Life Insurance Company. According to Form "D" on file, this Policy was a 20 year endowment plan, which was taken out on June 6, 1941. In view of the fact that the first annual premium was not fully paid, the policy lapsed in March, 1942.

Securities Two \$5.00 War Savings Certificates, held in the name of the above Japanese, were forwarded to Ottawa on March 3, 1943, and on March 15, 1943, the Registrar of War Savings Certificates, Ottawa, forwarded to this office a cheque for \$8.08, representing redemption value of these Certificates. This amount was forwarded to Nishimura at the Internment Camp on March 22, 1943.

No property interests, other than those mentioned above, are found on this file.




