Seisaku MATSUMOTO died at Slokan, B. C. on February 18, 1946. He is survived by his widow, Koma, file #8103; three sons, Shigeo, file #597, Minoru, file #2728, and Masao who is not registered and is, presumably, still in Japan; and one daughter, Yuwa, who is also probably still in Japan.

The only assets declared by Seisaku MATSUMOTO were some household effects left at 2020 Yukon Street, Vancouver, B.C. These same chattels were also declared by his wife, Koma, and were handled on file #8103.

The Department of Labour filed a claim against the estate of Seisaku MATSUMOTO for recovery of the sum of \$80.00 to cover the funeral expenses of the deceased. They were advised by this office on March 22, 1946, that no funds were available from which to pay their claim.

NO CLAIMS, OTHER THAN THAT MENTIONED ABOVE, APPEAR ON THIS FILE.
