In accordance with a request made by your son, Yukio, dated December 14th, we remitted to him on December 24th, by registered mail, our Cheque No. 1907 payable to his order and amounting to \$200.00, representing payment on account against proceeds of sale made of the 1941 Chevrolet sedan which netted a total of \$873.02.

Although your son was secretary of Togo Cleaners Ltd. it now appears to us that it would have been more appropriate, before sending this money to him, to have referred the matter to you as the largest shareholder of Togo Cleaners Ltd.
