MEMORANDUM

TO: MR. H. F. GREEN

FROM: MR. K. W. WRIGHT

RE: Mantero UYENO

In regard to your inventory of October 26, 1944, we wrote the above named Internee asking him to identify the two dunnage bags by supplying us with a list of the contents. He replies as follows:

"I left two cloth bags, both of them about four feet long and brown in color. I don't believe I put my name or any tags on it.

One of them contained one quilt and two or three blankets; one brown, one gray color; one pair of bed sheets one bed cover, one pillow and other small things.

The other bag contained one quilt and working clothes. If possible I would like to leave them as they are, but if they must be put under the custody of the Custodian, then he may do so."
