LIABILITY SUMMARYRei WATANABE, Isamu (Mr.) Reg. No. 07396.

A review of the file of the above Japanese reveals that 3 claims have been filed against him:

Standard Oil Co. . . . .	\$62.98
Turner Meakin & Co. Ltd. . . . .	\$31.50
National Harbours Board. . . . .	\$1.50

The claim of the Standard Oil Co. was originally for \$98.27 but a payment of \$35.29 was made on November 24, 1941. The balance, \$62.98 was paid on February 5, 1943.

Turner Meakin's claim consisted of rent for June, July and August 1942 and was also settled on February 5, 1943.

The National Harbours Board's claim of \$1.50 for wharfage was not handed in until February 2, 1944 after the proceeds of the boat had all been remitted to the Japanese. We are waiting for the R.C.M.P. Radio receipt to release funds now in the account and enable us to settle this claim.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.
