File No. 959 dated January 4th 1944, regarding n/n.

The Internee states:-

"I wish to state that I presume the balance credited to my account is from the sale of Chrysler Crown Engine, which I left at the Phoenix Cannery, Steveston, B.C., however this engine is the property of my brother, Shizuo HASHIMOTO, now of c/o Leaverleigh Farm, R.R.1, Port Credit, Ontario. The engine had been brought to the cannery for my brother by me, and the cannery treated it as mine, as I was working as fish packer at the Cannery and naturally known better than my brother.

If the balance created in my credit is from the sale of the engine mentioned above, I wish that the Custodian will credit the amount to my brother's account for the reason as stated above.

To the best of my knowledge I cleared all my account with the Standard Oil Co. of B.C. In this connection I wish to refer to Mr Morgan, a salesman of the Company."
