## LICENCE

WHEREAS by regulation 39E of the Defence of Canada Regulations (Consolidated) 1942, it is provided that no person of the Japanese race shall, except as thereinafter provided, have the capacity, after the 24th day of February, 1942, during the continuation of the state of war now existing to acquire or hold land in Canada and that no conveyance made or executed after the said date shall be effective to convey to or for the benefit of a person of the Japanese race any land in Canada:

AND WHEREAS it is further provided that the Minister of Justice may, if it appears to him to be in the public interest so to do, grant to a person of the Japanese race a licence to acquire or hold land in Canada and that a person of the Japanese race to whom such a licence is granted shall have the capacity to acquire or hold land in Canada in accordance with the terms and conditions of such licence;

AND WHEREAS the corporation of the City of Prince Rupert in or about the month of September, 1940, agreed to sell lot 19, block 32, section 1, in the said City of Prince Rupert to one S. Kimura of the said City and the said S. Kimura has completed payment of the purchase price but the said lot has not been transferred into the name of the said S. Kimura;

AND WHEREAS the said S. Kimura has agreed to sell the said lot to one Gordon Madison of the said City of Prince Rupert, a person other than a person of the Japanese race;

AND WHEREAS application has been made to the Minister of Justice to grant to the said S. Kimura a licence under the said regulation 39E to acquire and hold the said Lot 19, Block 32, Section 1, in the said City of Prince Rupert for the purpose of transferring the said lot to the said Gordon Madison;

AND WHEREAS it appears to the Minister of Justice to be in the public interest to grant a licence to the said S. Kimura for such purpose.

NOW THEREFORE I, Louis S. St. Laurent, Minister of Justice, hereby grant to S. Kimura, formerly of the said City of Prince Rupert in the Province of British Columbia, a licence to acquire and hold the said Lot 19, Block 32, Section 1, in the said City of Prince Rupert for the purpose of transferring the said lot to Gordon Madison, Esq., of the said City of Prince Rupert, subject to the condition that, if the said lot be not transferred by the said S. Kimura to the said Gordon Madison forthwith after the said lot has been acquired by the said S. Kimura, this licence shall be deemed to be cancelled and to be of no further force and effect.
