CHATELS: The above, who made her declaration to the Custodian on April 3/42 and was evacuated on May 20/42, declared chattels as listed on Chattel Schedule on file, left at House #21, Pacific Coast Cannery. These were inventoried on June 25/42 by Custodian agent, G.C. Robinson, and removed to storage warehouse #1. On Oct. 26/42, the B.C.S.C. shipped one stove to the above at the request of their Kaslo Supervisor. We sent her a copy of the inventory sheet on Nov. 28/42, which she confirmed on Dec. 4/42, and adding to this list which she signed and returned, one kitchen stove and heater. Chattels were sold for the net sum of \$13.63 and this sum credited to the account of the above.

The file reveals that the above owned no specified articles.

MONEYS We received the sum of \$5.00 from the B.C.E. R. in favour of the above,
RECEIVABLE: being a refund of security deposit for light. This sum was credited to her account with the Custodian.


Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:
