When Mr. Sato left we promised to take all reasonable care of these belongings for him and at any time he wished them forwarded we would do so at his request. This box of goods is well tied up and has not been opened and will not be until delivered to him or on orders from your department. We will take all reasonable care in looking after these effects while in our care.

Mr. Sato was the only Japanese employee who entrusted any property to our care.
