


Re: Policy #163,788 - April (S) - on the life  
of Yoshikazu Mori

Further to your recent letter, we are pleased to enclose a Cash Surrender Discharge Form, which shows a net amount obtainable on this policy through surrender of it as \$603.51. If Mr. Mori will sign the Discharge Form as the insured, have his signature witnessed and return this document together with the policy, we will be pleased to have a cheque issued.

We would perhaps be remiss in our duty if we gave effect to his request without pointing out that his policy was issued at rates much cheaper than those now obtainable, without a War Clause or any restriction as to travel or occupation, and on a policy form more favorable than used by this or any other company now. Under these circumstances, if Mr. Mori's present need is only to raise money temporarily, he would be much better off to take a loan on his policy for whatever amount he needs, and if he does not borrow too much, the policy would carry itself for a year or two or until such time as his circumstances allow him to continue making premium payments or repay the loan. He could borrow up to an amount of \$595.00, which is only slightly less than the maximum surrender value available. If he wished to make a loan instead of surrendering the policy, he should complete, instead of the Surrender Discharge Form, both copies of the attached Loan Agreements and again his beneficiary's signature will not be necessary. The Loan Agreements have not been filled in as we do not know how much he wishes to borrow, but if he will simply sign them, have his signature witnessed, send in his policy and let us know what net amount he would like to borrow, we will complete the documents and return one copy to him with our cheque.

We shall look forward to hearing from you in due course.






