We have a letter from the British Columbia Security Commission relative to personal effects of several interness. Copy of this communication is enclosed. We have not examined the contents of the suitcases and boxes but it occurs to us if they contain warm clothing you might find use for the articles in camp and may wish to turn them over to the owners rather than to allow the goods to remain in storage. It will be noted from the enclosed letter that the majority of the internees have credit balances with us; we have inserted the amount in red type; so that we could pay the charges if you wish us to send the goods. We do not know what facilities you have for storage and it may be that you would not permit them to your thert ordinary outside clothing. If you would like us to make an examination and send you the list, this will be done upon receipt of your instructions. Yours truly, K. W.
