This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 24, 1942. He was evacuated on April 21, 1942.

In his declaration he reported a boat "M.S." in custody at Prince Rupert. In October, 1944, the British Columbia Packers Limited informed us that on March 27, 1942 SEKO received the sum of \$325.00 in payment of his equity in this boat, which was licensed in the name of B. C. Packers Ltd.

He reported a \$5.00 War Saving Certificate in his own possession. This did not come under the control of this office.

The account of this man was credited with the sum of \$5.00 as refund of expenses incurred at the time of the impounding of the vessel "M.S."

This file reveals no other property of any kind.

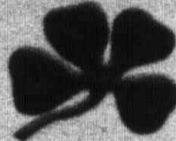
