2. The cost of the funeral and who paid for it.

In your letter to me you enclosed a copy of a letter from the Department of Labour in which they ask for \$80.00 to cover the funeral expenses.

In a copy of another letter from W. D. Graham dated February 10, 1946, he quotes from a letter he received from the deceased's son, in which the son says:

"The funeral expenses have been paid by my sister-in-law, I think, and my wife. Masaye or sister-in-law ordered for services of the undertaker."

Could you tell me what relation Masaye and the sister-in-law are and their names. If they did pay for the funeral do they want the amount refunded?

3. In your letter to me you say the assets are a credit balance held by your Department of \$167.96. In the copy of the letter from the deceased's son, he says:

"I know the deceased has a property with two storey dwelling at the north-east corner of 5th Ave. and Chatham Streets, Steveston, B. C., and had a Bank account in the Royal Bank of Canada, Steveston, B. C. Branch."
