PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

May 27, 1946.

Re: Tadao YAMAZAKI, Reg. No. 08695

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on April 3, 1942. He was evacuated on April 23, 1946.

In his declaration he reported household goods, fishing equipment, a net and rowboat stored at North Galliano, B.C. at the Home Gas Station. These were apparently left in a house rented by three Japanese at \$5.00 per month. On August 2, 1943, we received a letter signed by this man and the two other Japanese in which they agreed to the sale of the equipment stored, the proceeds to be applied on the rent of the house. In a letter written on June 2, 1944, by Mrs. Elisabeth Allison of the Home Oil Station she informed us that the house had been given up and all chattels of any value shipped to the Japanese.

The records of the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee show that this man was the owner of a boat "Roaming Chief". This boat was sold and the net proceeds in the amount of \$1,381.00 were paid to YAMAZAKI on April 2, 1942.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.

Further to my memorandum of August 30th, 1943, I have now written to Mrs. Allison as per letter of today's date.

The present position seems to be as follows:

(1) Mr. Tadao Yamazaki, file 1053. His fishing equipment will be doubtless covered in Mrs. Allison's reply in which connection her letter of July 15th last year indicates that everything of this nature was apparently sold before evacuation ("I was never given any fishing equipment belonging to Mr. Nakata and there is certainly none here, as he and Mr. Tadao Yamazaki were the last to leave here and they sold all they could to white fishermen"). Some items were evidently taken to Steveston (Note letter of July 15th referred to above on file 1063 and "JP" form) and this will require a further check.

(2) Mr. Minosuke Nakata, file 1063. Here again, the fishing equipment seems to have been disposed of before evacuation despite the "JP" declaration.

(3) Mr. and Mrs. Saichi Hama, file Nos. 2134, 3394. These files appear to be closed except for any information forthcoming from Mrs. Allison, by the Japanese having declared nothing.

I have given the house up to the Indian owner last month, there was nothing of real value in the house, as I found out the nets were of little value owing to the mesh being under size according to the Department of Fisheries, and the rats had destroyed a lot of the Web.

I have shipped Mrs Hama all her kitchen goods, and as you know I shipped her sewing machine and I packed the drawers full of all the small articles I could find.

They all seem very satisfied and write very nice letters of thanks to me for all I have done for them, and I have told them I have given up the house.

So I think we had better consider this matter closed and I trust this meets with your kind approval.




