

Considerable confusion has arisen on these files from the fact that there exists a P/WA-313 - Shigeo SHUTO and an Evacuee, Shigeo SHUDO, # 12757. The latter made declaration of a parcel of land which was found to be registered in the name of Shigeo SHUTO.

This confusion is now explained by a statement made by Shigeo SHUDO as it appears on the J.P. form that until recently his name was SHUTO as it appears on the Title to the land. As the Certificate of Vesting was made on the Enemy form of Vesting and filed as #24593, it is desirable to vacate the same and file one on the Evacuee form. This is being done and the proper forms are attached.

Re: Life Insurance Cancellations.

The following is a copy of the letter we have been sending out to the Insurance Companies relative to cancellations:

"Your communication of the 20th ult. addressed to this office indicates that Policy #2,241,220 carried by the above named internee is no longer in force.

The Custodian does not recognize the right to cancel the policy as it is vested in the Custodian, due to the fact that this man has been interned.

We understand that all such policies are being kept in suspense accounts; therefore any action which you may take is without prejudice to the Custodian's rights under the Consolidated Regulations Respecting Trading With The Enemy (1939)."

We have your memo confirming Mr. McPherson's statement at a recent meeting, and it would appear that the Insurance Companies' objection relates to suspense accounts which the Companies are not permitted to open. We are striking out the first part of the third paragraph so that the letter will read as follows:

"Your communication of the 20th ult. addressed to this office indicates that Policy #2,241,220 carried by the above named is no longer in force.

The Custodian does not recognize the right to cancel the policy as the policy holder has been interned and all his property is vested in the Custodian.

Any action which you may take is therefore without prejudice to the Custodian's rights under the Consolidated Regulations Respecting Trading With The Enemy (1939)."
