Dear Sir: File 1060 - Junichi Nagasuye #10542.

We have your letter of September 29, advising that the above named has declared that we are indebted to him to the extent of about \$20.00 for wages.

This is quite incorrect. On April 18th we received a letter from the lad's father, I. Nagasuye, asking that we forward his son's wage cheque to him. Junichi had been moved apparently and had asked the father to write us to this effect.

We saw no reason why the request should not be complied with and immediately forwarded a certified cheque for \$27.80, wages in full, in favour of J. Nagasuye, to the father. The cancelled cheque is in our possession, endorsed and apparently ~~xxxxxx~~ cashed through H. Furuya Co.

If this information does not straighten the matter out and you wish us to forward the cancelled cheque, we shall be glad to do so.

This man did not carry his cheque away with him from Prince Rupert because the Japs were evacuated quickly from this area and at the time the writer was in Vancouver.
