This file reveals the above owned no real property in any protected area of British Columbia and he did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATELS: The above, who made his declaration to the Custodian on March 23/42 and was evacuated on March 26/42, declared miscellaneous tools stored at 49 Alexander St., Vancouver. Two axes and two cross cut saws were recovered by the Custodian from this address and sold at auction for the net sum of \$3.26 and this sum was credited to the account of the above. On Nov. 13/42 NAGANO confirmed by letter that these tools were his only property in the restricted area of British Columbia.

The file reveals the above owned no specified articles.

MONIES The above declared an account in the sum of \$50.00 owing to him by Mr. RECEIVABLE: George O'Brien for wages. When we wrote to Mr. O'Brien about this account he stated he knew nothing about the matter. We advised NAGANO of this and in his letter of Dec. 7/42 NAGANO states that his account with Mr. O'Brien had already been settled.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.
