an evacuated Japanese who has been living on premises owned by The  
Canadian Fishing Company Limited.

This man has been occupying House No. 51 on our  
property and his family is still living in the house. The rental  
basis with this and other Japanese families has been \$10.00 per month  
and this man has paid up until the end of December, 1941.

We presume that as long as we allow the families  
of evacuated Japanese to live on Company property that the Custodian  
will see the usual rent is paid to our Company.


