Dear Sir. Reference to file # 1070.

I wish to thank you for your letter of April 1 in reference to refund on steamship tickets. As to explanation I guess I should be ignorant or call it following other people's advice. When my family boarded the Union Steamship boat at Telegraph Cove, I was told to purchase 1st class tickets which were to be refunded at a later date. The purser stamped tickets and gave me the vouchers which I forwarded to you. On arrival in Vancouver we were hustled off to Hastings Park. The rest you should know.

The vouchers which I received, I thought were only the passenger portion of the ticket. I also showed them to the steward in the dining salon in order to secure my meals also for wife.

(b) I did not know that I had to apply for a refund on transportation. I just got that information from the weekly newspaper "The New Canadian" of a fortnight ago. I hope that this delay will not cause you trouble. ✓

On information on luggage do I write to the Security Commission in Lethbridge or at Vancouver. The stenographer here in Lethbridge does not know and we cannot see Mr. Russell except on 2 days per week.

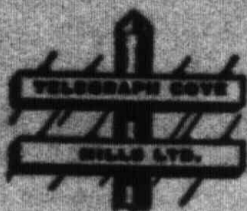
