1. With reference to the above, in the p.m. of the 20 th instant the above captionally noted Canadian born Japanese was arrested on Powell St., City, and asked to produce his evacuation notice. When asked, this subject produced B.C.I.C. notice telling him to report to Hastings Park on April 28th., 1942. This he failed to do and upon being questioned he stated that unless he could have mass evacuation he would not go to camp.

2. He was placed under arrest and taken to the Immigration Sheds, where he was turned over to the officer i/c Military detail for safe keeping. Receipt obtained for his living body is being kept on file at this point.



Dear Madam;

In reply to your letter of October 28th last, in regard to your son's policy noted above, we regret to advise you that we have no funds at present to your son's credit with which to pay his Life Insurance Premium.

Information supplied us by the Insurance Company indicates that the policy contains an automatic non-forfeiture clause which would keep the policy in force until the full surrender value has been applied to settlement of the premiums not paid by the policyholder.

We note in your letter of March 9th last, to Frederick Field, Controller of the Japan and Canada Trust Savings Company, that you claim to have, in your name, Account No. T-2550, with the Japan and Canada Trust Savings Company. We are informed that this account is not in your name, and we would ask you to kindly advise us if the account belonged to any other member of your family. If you are in possession of the Japan and Canada Trust Savings Company Pass Book No. T-2550, will you please forward it to us, so that we may make further investigation of this matter.

In reply to your letter of February 2nd, I wish to state that the account in the Japan and Canada Trust Savings Company is under the name of G. Tauji. Although the account is under the name of G. Tauji, the possessor of the savings is Mr. Nakanishi, and this money cannot be used to furnish for the insurance premium of my son's policy.

Please ask the insurance company to change this policy to an Automatic Non-Forfeiture Clause, because I am in a situation where I cannot possibly make any remittance for my son's insurance premiums for the duration.

From now on I would appreciate it very much if you would not send me any more letters, because I being unable to understand English is very difficult for me to ask a person to write for me every time I receive a letter from you. Added to this the expense on stamps run up to quite a bit for a person who is receiving maintenance.
