This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 24, 1942. He was evacuated on April 21, 1942.

In his declaration he reported a box of books, 3 boxes of kitchen utensils and a guitar left c/o B. E. Morgan, Prince Rupert, B.C. Mrs. Morgan informed us that a guitar was sent to NISHIO on June 28, 1942, and no further disposition is shown of these articles. We are today writing Mr. Morgan.

He reported 2 cameras in custody of the police. These were surrendered under the name of Arakichi NISHIO and handled on file 1454.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.
