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The above Japanese person did not declare any debts on his JP form dated March 18, 1943, but a review of this file reveals that the following claims were filed against him:

In writing to Mr. Nishimura regarding Dr. Uchida's claim he replied that this was incorrect as he had never at any time been examined by Dr. Uchida. On January 14, 1943 he wrote to Dr. Uchida for confirmation and he advised in his letter to us of January 10th, 1943, that he had examined the above because on February 1942 but the sum concerned being a small one, he was disregarding it. He advised Nishimura accordingly on February 8, 1943.

With respect to the claim of \$6.63 by McLellan & McCarter Limited, this was denied by Nishimura in his letter to us of November 25, 1942; he stated that he had never had any dealings with this company. No further action was taken by this office regarding this claim.

No other claims against the above Japanese person are revealed on this file.
