Referring to our conversation of today regarding the above mentioned family, our records show that the father suffers from semi paresis of the left side and is unfit for employment. The father, mother, and two underage children are in receipt of maintenance, Mr YONEKURA also receiving and additional amount for medical extras, bringing the total maintenance to \$39.40 per month. In December Mrs YONEKURA was supplied with glasses at a cost of \$9.50.

A perusal of the file would indicate that the eldest son Hiroshi came from the east on a visit to his parents about five weeks ago with the intention of marrying and returning to Toronto with his bride - we have up to this time no advice as to whether or not this marriage took place. Our Welfare Officer endeavoured to have Hiroshi assist his family but to no avail.
