GENERAL SUMMARY

Re: Michio NISHIMURA #1186

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 24, 1942. He was evacuated on May 30, 1942.

In his declaration he reported ownership of the vessel "Silver Sea". This vessel was sold through the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee, and the net proceeds of \$344.00 were paid to NISHIMURA on April 2, 1942.

He reported \$105.00 in War Savings Certificates on his person. We have no record of the redemption of these Certificates.

He reported a Japan & Canada Trust Savings Account of \$351.00, but as his name was not on the list of depositors of that bank, as at December 31, 1942, it would appear that all funds must have been withdrawn before that date.

He reported a Manufacturers Life Policy #796095, on his person. Policy was for \$1,500.00. We are communicating with the company to find the present state of this policy.

His account was credited with \$50.25 in full settlement of the claim lodged with the Japanese Fishing Vessels Disposal Committee for refund of expenses incurred at the time of the impounding of his vessel.

The RCMP reported that this man had surrendered a camera. This camera is now at 604 Cordova Street, and is being released to Funiyo NISHIMURA, File 9125, his wife. Cost of shipping the camera will be charged to the funds now in the account of Michio NISHIMURA. *Mark Flanagan*

Funds in the account of Michio NISHIMURA are to be remitted to his wife, as Michio NISHIMURA is not in a position to receive funds.
