On September 25th, 1942, our records indicate that the sums of \$2.03 and \$10.22, representing wages due from the Department of Mines & Resources, were received from the Department of Labour, Japanese Division and credited to Kenzo Mori's account with the Custodian. At his request (Oct.27/42) we forwarded our cheque for \$12.25 to Mr. Mori, in care of the Camp Commandant at Angler Ontario.
2. On January 26, 1944 the sum of \$50.00, representing arrears of wages from the Canada Daily News, was credited to Mr. Mori's account in this office.
3. Also, the amount of \$5.61 has been credited to this man's account with the Custodian, representing refund of 1% wage deductions for the first half of 1941 by the Provincial Collector, Vancouver.
