#### RE: Yasuliro NAKANISHI, Meg.No.04558

The above, in his declaration to the Pustodian, dated April 3/42, declared 1 noter book TY.N.T in custody at New Westminster, and fishing year valued at \$500.00, left in the net house of the 5.V. Packers (Imperial Connery), Steveston.

Tasujiro NAKANISHI wrote to us on November 6/42 inquiring about his note which he had left at the Imperial Cannery. There is a note on file opposite this letter stating that no nots were inventoried in the name of T.NAKANISHI\*, at the Imperial Cannery, but a lot of nots inventoried in the name of "T. NAKANISHI". He was advised of this in our letter of Nov. 12/42. He replied to this letter on Nov. 23/42 describing just where his note had been left in the not house and drawing a plan of the not house to assist us in finding the note. This plan together with a memo of Nov. 28/42 was forwarded to C.G.Robinson. We still could not locate the note and NAKANISHI was advised to this effect in our letter of Jan. 21/43. He was also advised in the same letter that the Imperial Cannery (5 G.Packers) had an account against him in the sum of \$205.00 and that any note of his found and sold would have to go to defray this debt. He confirmed this debt in his letter of Nept. 18/42, but stated that his note should bring much more than the amount of the debt.

Mr. Abbinson states in his memo of Oct. 15/43 that the imperial Cannery have no note on their lists in the name of the above, but that they had four note in the name of Tamejiro NAKANISHI. We wrote to the above on Oct. 19/43 giving him this information and enclosing a not form for him to fill out, in order that we might check the note credited to Tamejiro MAKANISHI and see if any of them should have been credited to Tamejiro. In his reply to this letter he simply stated that he had the following:

1 Sockeye net - 500 Pathons

Spring net - 120 \*

Lead and cork line - 5 sets for hanging

He also added in this letter that he had two row boats also in the dennery not house as well as his nets and lines. However none of this equipment was found. See Fr. Green's memo of March 5/44. The above was advised of this again in our letter of March 9/44.

However, he refers and keeps referring to certain fishing gear and nets that he claims he left with the Imperial Cannery at Steveston, B.C. at the time of evacuation. Our file, however, has a memorandum that the Imperial Cannery has no nets on their list in this man's name.

Apparently this memorandum was made after consulting with you people. We are just in receipt of another lengthy letter from him regarding all this, which he still seems to think are assets that will produce him funds with which to pay your account.

In view of the foregoing, and the apparent impossibility of locating anything of these nets or gear, it does not appear likely that we shall be able to do more to effect collection of your account.
