CHATTEL SUMMARY

The above, in his declaration to the Custodian, dated April 3/42, declared 1 motor boat "I.N." in custody at New Westminster, and fishing gear valued at \$500.00, left in the net house of the B.C. Packers (Imperial Cannery), Steveston.

The fishing vessel was sold through the Japanese Fishing Vessel Disposal Committee on March 28/42 for the net sum of \$492.50, which amount was ~~XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX~~ paid to him on March 31/42.

Yasujiro NAKANISHI wrote to us on November 6/42 inquiring about his nets which he had left at the Imperial Cannery. There is a note on file opposite this letter stating that no nets were inventoried in the name of Y.NAKANISHI, at the Imperial Cannery, but a lot of nets inventoried in the name of "T. NAKANISHI". He was advised of this in our letter of Nov. 12/42. He replied to this letter on Nov. 23/42 describing just where his nets had been left in the net house and drawing a plan of the net house to assist us in finding the nets. This plan together with a memo of Nov. 28/42 was forwarded to C.C. Robinson. We still could not locate the nets and NAKANISHI was advised to this effect in our letter of Jan. 21/43. He was also advised in the same letter that the Imperial Cannery (B.C. Packers) had an account against him in the sum of \$205.00 and that any nets of his found and sold would have to go to defray this debt. He confirmed this debt in his letter of Sept. 18/42, but stated that his nets should bring much more than the amount of the debt.

Mr. Robinson states in his memo of Oct. 15/43 that the Imperial Cannery have no nets on their lists in the name of the above, but that they had four nets in the name of Tamejiro NAKANISHI. We wrote to the above on Oct. 19/43 giving him this information and enclosing a net form for him to fill out, in order that we might check the nets credited to Tamejiro NAKANISHI and see if any of them should have been credited to Yasujiro. In his reply to this letter he simply stated that he had the following:

1 Sockeye net - 500 Fathoms
Spring net - 120 "
Lead and cork line - 5 sets for hanging

He also added in this letter that he had two row boats also in the cannery net house as well as his nets and lines. However none of this equipment was found. See Mr. Green's memo of March 5/44. The above was advised of this again in our letter of March 9/44.

Apparently this memorandum was made after consulting with you people. We are just in receipt of another lengthy letter from him regarding all this, which he still seems to think are assets that will produce him funds with which to pay your account.

In view of the foregoing, and the apparent impossibility of locating anything of these nets or gear, it does not appear likely that we shall be able to do more to effect collection of your account.
