CHATELS:

The above, who made his declaration to the Custodian on March 19/42 and was evacuated on July 27/42, declared clothing and golf clubs at 620 E. 16th Ave., Vancouver. As we did not find these articles we wrote to the above on Jan. 21/42 telling him that we assumed he had either sold these chattels or otherwise disposed of them prior to his evacuation. He signed a copy of this letter confirming that this was the case.

SPECIFIED ARTICLES:

A Victor radio belonging to the above was received by the Custodian from the R.C.M.P. and was sold at Vancouver auction No. 2 for the net sum of \$31.79, and this sum was credited to his account with this office, and is his entire balance.

We also received a camera from the R.C.M.P. belonging to MIYAZAWA and we are today writing to him and asking him to send us the R.C.M.P. receipt for both the radio and camera and also funds to cover cost of mailing his camera to him.

WAR SAVINGS CERTIFICATES:

The above declared \$320.00 in War Savings Certificates. These did not come under the control of the Custodian.

BANK ACCOUNT:

The above declared a bank account with the Royal Bank of Canada, Kingsway Branch, in the sum of \$250.00. This did not come under the control of the Custodian.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

It is noted that you were the owner of a radio which you surrendered to the Royal Canadian Mounted Police. This radio has been sold by the Custodian for the net sum of \$31.79 and this sum credited to your account. This sum will be made available to you as soon as we receive from you the receipt which you obtained from the Royal Canadian Mounted Police at the time the radio was surrendered.

We also have a camera of yours which will be mailed to you as soon as we have the Royal Canadian Mounted Police receipt for it, together with the sum of twenty five cents to cover cost of packing and mailing.

Dear Sir:

In accordance with your request we enclose herewith Custodian cheque in the sum of \$31.63, being the proceeds from sale of your radio less sixteen cents for packing and mailing charges on your camera.

When you made your declaration to the Custodian you declared clothing and golf clubs at 620 East 15th Avenue, Vancouver. As these were not found at this address we wrote you on January 21st, 1943, stating that we assumed these had either been taken with you at the time of your evacuation or that you had disposed of them prior to that date. You confirmed this by signing and sending back to us a copy of this letter.

You declared War Savings Certificates to the value of \$320.00. These did not come under the control of the Custodian.

You also declared a bank account with the Royal Bank of Canada, Kingsway Branch, in the sum of \$250.00. This did not come under the control of the Custodian.

The folding camera which you surrendered to the Royal Canadian Mounted Police was delivered by them to the Custodian. This camera was mailed to you yesterday.

As previously mentioned your radio was sold for the net sum of \$31.79, and from this we have deducted the cost of packing and mailing your camera, leaving you a balance of \$31.63.

It would appear that we have accounted for all the property of every kind left by you in the protected area which vested in the Custodian, and in order that you may confirm this and acknowledge the cheque, we are enclosing a stamped addressed envelope for convenience in replying.
