This man, in his declaration to the Custodian on March 27, 1942, reported a quantity of household and personal effects stored with Mr. & Mrs. Nishikawa, 758 Powell Street. Memorandum on file dated December 8, 1942, states that Mr. Logan investigated these premises and was informed that no Japanese chattels were there. This information was sent to MIZUNO on July 2, 1943. As no reply was received it is apparent that MIZUNO had disposed of his chattels prior to his evacuation, or that these were disposed of by his wife who did not leave the protected area until the 1st of June, 1942.

This file reveals no other property, except the Victory Bonds and War Savings Certificates reported as being in the possession of MIZUNO at the time of his declaration. These did not come under the control of this office.

This file reveals no liabilities.
